

**First Annual  
Quilter's Rule Tool Challenge  
Honoring our Military**

1. Any combination of cotton fabric may be used. We encourage the use of bold patriotic colors, i.e. Red, White and Blue.
2. You **must use the Creative Curves Multi-Angle Tool**. You have the option of using the Creative Curves Pattern, Quilts of Valor Sampler, or an original pattern of your own using the Multi-Angle Tool.
3. The quilt must conform to the rules for Quilts of Valor found at <http://www.govf.org/content/basic-qov-requirements.html>.
  - A. In addition to the above stated rules the quilts must be bound and quilted.
  - B. Each quilt must have a sleeve attached to the top back for hanging. The sleeve opening must be 4 inches wide after it is attached to the quilt, and must be attached in a way that it will not show when the quilt is hanging. The sleeve must be easily removed for presentation.
  - C. No embellishments other than thread are allowed.
  - D. Read and understand the QOV rules.
4. All quilts submitted are made for donation to military veterans in 2013. We would consider it a great honor if you attended and assisted in the donation of your quilt to the military recipient. Date to be determined later.
5. Quilts will travel with Quilter's Rule for 12 months prior to the being donated at the 2013 Machine Quilting Today, LLC, Upper MidWest Show, Oconomowoc, WI.
6. Your entry must be received by Quilter's Rule at 817 Mohr Avenue, Waterford WI 53185, no later than July 15, 2012 for the first hanging and judging at the Machine Quilting Today, LLC, Upper MidWest Show
7. The traveling portion of the Competition is limited to 25 quilts meeting all requirements. There may be more than one traveling exhibit.
8. The show judges will judge submitted quilts in August 2012.
9. Product and ribbon awards will be made.
10. Multiple entries are not allowed.
